The Elizabeth Hurlock Beckman Award has distributed more than \$3.5 million to 148 professors throughout the United States since 2010, honoring current or former academic faculty who have inspired a former student "to create an organization which has demonstrably conferred a benefit on the community at large or to establish on a lasting basis a concept, procedure, or movement of comparable benefit to the community at large."

Gail Beckman created this Award in honor of her mother, Dr. Elizabeth Hurlock Beckman, a pioneer in the field of psychology, one of the first female psychology professors at Columbia University, author of nine books and textbooks on child and adolescent psychology, champion of gender equality, and advocate for the advancement of women in academia.
